## **INFORMATION FOR AUTHORS**

#### **General Guidelines for Manuscript Submission**

Authors should submit their manuscript as an attached file via E-mail hensyu@jiep.or.jp to the **Transactions of The Japan Institute of Electronics Packaging (Trans JIEP),** according to specified style and format as shown below. JIEP Membership is not required.

Original and unpublished papers are preferred. However, a paper presented at conferences or published in those proceedings are acceptable. Moreover, the papers, that are published in the Journal of The Japan Institute of Electronics Packaging, will be also acceptable if they are submitted within one year after publication. A page charge will apply for all accepted papers according to the number of pages in their final form.

## **Technical Contents of Manuscript**

The technical contents of papers should be new and significant with the exception of review or tutorial papers. Experimental data should be complete and should include sufficient description of experimental apparatus, methods, and experimental conditions.

## **Manuscript Style**

- (1) Prepare a manuscript in single-column, double-spaced format.
- (2) Provide "paper title," "name(s) of author(s)," affiliation of author(s)," and "postal address and e-mail address".
- (3) Provide an informative 50 to 200 word "abstract," followed by selected 5 to 10 "keywords".
- (4) References appear as a separate section at the end of the paper, with items referred to by numerals in square brackets. References should be complete and in the Journal of JIEP style.
- (5) Provide a separate page listing all figure captions in proper style for the typesetter.
- (6) Refer to all tables and illustrations in the text. The initial references to illustrations and tables in the text should be numerically sequential.
- (7) Use metric units, more specifically the International System of Units. If custom or convenience dictates British-American units for specific uses, the metric equivalent should be given also in parentheses.
- (8) This Trans JIEP follows the practices of the Journal of JIEP, as outlined in the Institute's published standards. Use only standard symbols and abbreviations unless defined when first used in the text. Be sure that all subscripts, superscript, Greek letters, and mathematical symbols are clearly identified. Authors should take special care to make all mathematical expressions legible. Do not give derivations that are easily found in the literature; merely cite the reference.
- (9) Avoid the use of trade and company names and proprietary terms whenever possible. Likewise, avoid "nationalisms," as in the following examples: our space program; power systems throughout the nation; research supported by the government.
- (10) Provide a biography (about 90 words) and photograph for each author.
- (11) For further information, see "Transactions of The Japan Institute of Electronics Packaging-Information for Authors".

## **Graphics Preparation**

- (1) Prepare in Word, Power Point, Excel, or other adequate formats.
- (2) Use consistent typefaces in all figures. Figures will be reduced to make the smallest type size 8 points. It is suggested to use Times New Roman font. All of figures should be in the same size (width × length) whenever possible. For scanned graphics the original material should be no larger than 22×28 cm.
- (3) Either a black and white file or a color file is allowable to submit .

# Submission of Final Manuscript

After reviewer-requested revisions have been made, we ask that you submit the final manuscript electronically, accompanied by a printed version that exactly reflects the text in the file. Details will be provided upon acceptance of the manuscript for publication. For further information, see "Transactions of The Japan Institute of Electronics Packaging - Information for Authors".

#### Page Proofs

Page proofs are sent to the principal author just prior to publication of the manuscript. Minor and typographical errors should be noted and corrected according to the instructions enclosed with the proofs. Major changes required to correct errors in the manuscript will not, in general, be permitted. In order to avoid a major change, the authors should prepare the manuscript very carefully before submission.

#### Page Charges

The manuscript submission fee (JY 3,000/printed page, tax excluded) is required for a regular paper. You can get the reprints of your paper if you request to JIEP. The prices are shown below.
